ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA!

Dear followers of Christ,

We, who journeyed with our Lord through the forty days of Lent, just reached the point of victory at which our Lord presents himself to us as the Risen Christ. Today and in the days to come, we see "Happy Easter" signs in shopping centres, train stations, and various other places, for Easter Sunday signals a time of joy and hope. Our hope today is not solely rooted in Jesus' return from the area of death but also in his call for us to embrace the resurrection life, where all that we have lost is restored.

Resurrection implies a sense of restoration. The Risen Christ restored what his disciples had lost. When Jesus was arrested, his disciple lost a sense of peace, the



motivation to proclaim Jesus's message of love and first and foremostly their identity as followers of Christ. None of them stayed with Jesus, instead they fled. Even Thomas doubted the real presence of the Risen Christ. Perhaps we require strength, confidence, or motivation, based on our past experiences. The Risen Christ returns to us to hear our needs. Let us be honest with him, that we may be fully immersed in the life of resurrection, where our sole necessities are the love and hope of Christ.


